



Pre Survey Checklist

Our goal at TEC Marine Surveying is to provide factual and accurate information about your vessel and its condition at the time of survey. To help ensure a safe, accurate and efficient survey can be conducted please review the checklist and prepare before your surveyor arrives. Thank you.

Please have a copy of the certificate of ownership and registration documents or a copy on board showing the vessel's particulars and the ownership declaration.

Please have any copies of previous survey reports made available for review by the surveyor.

Please have a name of the broker, seller and finance company available if required.

Please remove all personal items stored in under deck storage area, forward rope locker and engine room to enable inspection of these spaces. If these are not removed, we will not inspect the spaces.

If a sea trial is to be conducted as part of the survey please make sure the following has been addressed.

The fuel tank has sufficient fuel for the voyage.

The batteries to be fully charged to enable operation of the engine and electronics.

The engine cooling system to be filled.

All engine instruments to be operational.

All shore connections to be disconnected, i.e. fresh water supply, electricity and other connections.

Steering gear to be fully operational.

All loose items to be secured.

If the vessel is to be sailed please make sure all sails and rigging are available for trial and all appropriate hardware is serviceable.

The above requirements are intended to reduce the possibility of unforeseen accidents. Please note that TEC Marine Surveying cannot be held liable for any loss or damage during the survey.
